The NayStation is an eclectic mix of a dining & meeting space, a bed & breakfast, natural history & antiques museum and a bake shop. Most of all it is our Ohana and we hope you will make it your Ohana by joining the Club with your family and friends. Located on the mauka side of King Kamehameha Blvd. between Mahi-Mahi and Ohia, we have a splendid sunset view of the shore from Miloli'i to South Point.

The Dining Club is open every Saturday evening, serving fresh home-made fare. An announcement will be sent to members to let you know the menu for the next month. All you have to do is make a reservation. We can seat only 20 people a night, so plan ahead and call early!

Dinner is a fixed-price menu that includes a choice of entrée and dessert. Sides dishes and house beverages are included. The Club does not provide alcoholic beverages, however you are welcome to bring your own and we will provide the glass.
